The Easton Lions Club will be conducting our **34th Annual Charity Auction!** We hope you will be as excited about the new format as we are!

In lieu of live telephone bidding, we will be having a **one week online Charity Auction** starting on February 29 and culminating in an exciting **televised Celebration of Easton Community**Service dinner event on Saturday, March 7 at the Richardson Olmsted café (101 Lothrop St.).

Why are we so excited and energized about our new format?

- We are <u>partnering</u> with many incredible <u>community service organizations</u> in Easton, including Friends of Yardley Wood Rink, HUGS, We Do Care, House of Possibilities, Ames Free Library, Diabetes Awareness Camp, Raising Multicultural Kids, YMCA, Oliver Ames Robotics Team, Boy Scouts, and Easton Citizens Emergency Response Team, to celebrate all the good that is being done right here in Easton with your generous support.
- Our <u>community partners</u> bring a <u>new energy</u> and a <u>new audience</u> for our Auction.
- We will be giving our community service partners the opportunity to get the word out through <u>live interviews</u> and <u>recorded videos</u> about how they are using the support of the Lions and our donors to make Easton a better place to live and work.
- In addition to the thousands of Easton residents who receive our Auction email blasts, we are expecting <u>hundreds of attendees</u> for the dinner event (tickets are \$35 each to cover the costs of the dinner; available online at EastonLionsAuction.org).
- And yes, <u>ECAT</u> will be <u>broadcasting</u> and <u>streaming</u> the event <u>live</u>! So, our usual audience can watch from home and share in the fun by bidding online throughout the event.
- We are also pleased that the elimination of live bidding by telephone will keep our costs even lower, meaning that much more support for the good causes supported by your generous donations!

How will the auction be run?

- Make your donations in the same manner as you have in the past (see below)
- We will be <u>promoting the donations</u> through multiple <u>email blasts</u> to thousands of Easton residents, as well as through <u>print</u> and <u>social media</u>. (We also expect to promote as many of our donors as possible during the live event.)

- All items will be available for <u>viewing and bidding online</u> from <u>February 29 through</u> <u>March 7</u> through the same auction website that we have successfully used for years.
- All donated items will be posted on our <u>auction website</u>, which includes a <u>description of your business and your donation</u>, item photo, business logo, and contact information (including a link to your website if desired).
- Our <u>audience</u>, including those participating online, attending the event, or watching from home, <u>join in the fun</u> by competing for their favorite items by <u>submitting their bids</u> <u>online</u> (through their own computer, their own cell phone, or with one of the laptops at the event).
- We will be <u>closing the bidding by groups of items</u> every half hour during the March 7th dinner event (smaller value items first, leading up to the exciting close out of our traditional "Big Board" items at the end).
- We will have an "<u>auctioneer</u>" who will be keeping our live and television audience updated and energized throughout!
