Parade Details

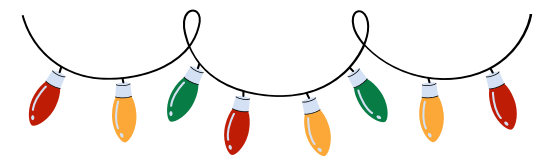
